

## **DRAFT Proposal the Amusement Parks and Tourist Trains Addendums to the Universal Guidelines for Task Force Consideration 3/9/2021**

### **Universal Guidelines Addendum A**

In addition to the Universal Guidance above the following industries must adhere to additional safety protocols:

#### **Amusement Parks:**

1. Amusement parks will limit attendance to allow guests or parties of guests, such as families and other groups, to be able to maintain appropriate social distancing of at least 6 feet from others that are not in their party.
2. All guests will be encouraged to pre-purchase tickets for admission prior to arrival. It is recommended that guests be given a time range to enter the amusement park in order to stagger arrivals and avoid lines outside the park of people waiting to enter.
3. Seating should be staggered to allow guests or parties of guests, such as families and other groups, to be able to maintain appropriate social distancing both side-to-side and front-to-back.
4. Game equipment, rafts, and tubes shall be cleaned and disinfected between each use. Rides shall be cleaned and disinfected at least every few hours and at the end of each shift.
5. Guests waiting in line to enter an amusement park, or for an attraction within an amusement park such as a ride or game, must follow social distancing guidelines. To that end, amusement parks must ensure all areas that create waiting lines have clear demarcations that space guests at least 6 feet apart and are located away from high-traffic areas through the park.
6. Retail settings must follow the Retail Establishments Guidance.
7. Food operations and settings must follow the Food Service Industry Guidance.
8. It is recommended that fixed height markers be added to attractions with height minimums to allow for visual verification. Additionally, where guests require stability assistance to get on rides, employees should minimize touching guests with their hands by first offering a shoulder or elbow. In these situations, guests and staff must both be wearing cloth face coverings and should both practice hand hygiene before and after each interaction.

### **Tourist Trains:**

1. Admission limits will be determined for daily and hourly capacities to ensure appropriate social distancing pursuant to the Universal Guidelines at recreational facilities. Advance reservations will have priority and general admission will be permissible based on availability.
2. Seating assignments should provide 6-feet of distancing within passenger cars when possible. Family members and related parties may be seated together. Passengers will be required to wear cloth face coverings while in the passenger car except while consuming food or beverage unless they are in compartmentalized seating.
3. All guests will be boarded directly onto the cars in which they are assigned to ride. Guests should be seated from back to front to limit anyone walking closer than needed. Guests shall be discouraged from moving from car to car or trading seats with other guests except for the use of rest rooms that are located in other cars or other extenuating circumstances.
4. Exiting the car should be done in a controlled fashion.
5. On days where circumstances permit, all windows in passenger coaches will be kept open to enhance the flow of fresh air within the passenger coaches. If windows are unable to be opened, increase outdoor air circulation inside the car using the cars' air conditioning/ventilation system. Do not re-circulate internal air. Car filters should be routinely serviced.
6. Retail settings must follow the Retail Establishments Guidance.
7. Food operations and settings must follow the Food Service Industry Guidance.
