

1. Personal Licensing Services

- a. **Massage:** Move to Universal Guidance - This has a section on mobile massage which is not allowed – will that be allowed in Phase II?

Also will the home-based massage requirements of separate entrances and restrooms be required in Phase II?

This also has treatment table set ups which I don't believe are in the Phase II UG.

It also requires sanitizing of all parts of the masseur's body that touch the patient which isn't in the UG.

- b. **Body Art:** Move to Universal Guidance

This has the requirement that all inks must be tightly closed and stored when not in use. I don't think this is in the UG.

This requires that the practitioner has to wear goggles or a shield in addition to a mask. I don't think that's in the UG

This has a requirement about how to use paper towels and that any out during the procedure must be destroyed at the end, even if not used. This isn't in the UG.

This also includes cleaning chairs between each customer's use which I don't think is in the UG.

- c. **Cosmetology, Barbering & Esthetics Services and Tanning Facilities:**
Move to Universal Guidance

This has pedicure/manicure specifics about no double-dipping, destroying unused product, and a requirement that the practitioner must wear gloves and a face shield that are not in the UG.

There is also a requirement that all face shields must be cleaned between clients and it states that this required for all body arts services. This isn't in the UG.

This talks about laundry which is talked about in several guidance documents but not in the UG.

- d. **Drive-In Theaters:** Move to Universal Guidance, Food Services Guidance, Retail Guidance and Large Group Gatherings Guidance

Portable toilets are required to prevent lines. That's not in the UG.

e. **Acupuncture:** Move to Universal Guidance
Same concerns with cosmetology and body art.

Different clinic infection control advisory (CCAOM) cited in this guidance.

This talks about using telehealth which really isn't in the UG.

This guidance requires a written exposure plan in accordance with OSHA regs which the UG does not discuss.

f. **Funeral Homes:** Move to Universal Guidance and Large Group Gatherings

This one has the requirement of providing tissues which we tried to get removed from the UG as it should not be a general business requirement – but requiring them in the funeral home makes sense.

This has a 50% limitation.

Otherwise, this could easily move to the UG.

2. **Museum / Art Galleries:** Move to Universal Guidance, Food Services Guidance, Retail Guidance and Large Group Gatherings Guidance

This has a group sale/guided tour restriction of 10 people. Does this change to unlimited?

This has a 50% capacity limit.

This has language on interactive exhibits that isn't in the UG but could be included in the cleaning section.

3. **Universal Guidance:** Amend page 3, section 4: add "or create a physical barrier between employees and customers or customers and customers"
