EXPERIENCE AND QUALIFICATIONS OF KEY STAFF & SUBCONTRACTORS Our evaluation will include an assessment of the history of your company, your company and its key staff members’ experience as it relates to the requirements within this RFP, evidence of past performance, quality and relevance of past work, references, and related items.</p>	30	
<p>2. APPROACH TO SCOPE OF WORK Our evaluation will include an assessment of the strategy, tactics and budget that will address the items of the Scope of Work in RFP Section 5.</p>	30	
<p>3. CREATIVITY/INNOVATION Our evaluation will include an assessment of the quality of proposed strategies and creativity as demonstrated by the required project.</p>	20	
<p>4. ABILITY TO MOBILIZE RESOURCES QUICKLY TO MEET PLANNING & FUNDING DEADLINES Our evaluation will include an assessment of timing and ability to mobilize resources quickly to meet the State’s required planning and funding deadlines.</p>	10	
<p>5. BUDGET APPROACH / COST EFFECTIVENESS Effective and efficient delivery of quality content and services is demonstrated in relation to the fee and value of overall project. The budget is reasonable and appropriate. Approach to fee structure is balanced and structured to maximize investment.</p>	10
