The Department of Administrative Services (DAS) proposes to dispose by transfer on behalf of the State of New Hampshire to Public Services Company of New Hampshire (d/b/a Eversource Energy) a perpetual utility line easement across a parcel of State land located at 296 Rochester Hill Road in the City of Rochester, NH, accommodate the installation of a new subsurface electrical

distribution line to serve the future Rochester Courthouse Facility.

On October 9, 2025, the Council on Resources and Development (CORD) voted to **recommend approval** of the above referenced Surplus Land Review application SLR 2025-006.
